- Submissions must be original, unpublished, and not under consideration elsewhere.

- The manuscript should be provided in Microsoft Word format.

- The manuscript should be between 3500 to 5000 words in length, including structured abstract, references, all tables, figures and appendix.

- The similarity index (plagiarism) of the manuscript must be below 10%.
